

BELDEN HOUSE

Litchfield, Connecticut

A 19th-century mansion in the picturesque town of Litchfield, Connecticut, has been brought back to life by the team behind the popular Troutbeck in nearby Amenia, New York. Under the design direction of Alexandra Champalimaud and overseen by her son, Anthony, and his family, Belden House is composed of 31 tastefully appointed rooms and suites across the main house and the modernist 1959 Mews (the historic 1891 Firehouse is also available for events). A sumptuous sitting room, convivial dining and bar area, fitness space, seasonal outdoor pool and lawn club are all drawing travelers and locals alike to this exciting area addition. Of special note are meals by chef Tyler Heckman infused with hyperlocal produce, Arethusa Farm cheeses and a stunning seafood plateau that is the talk of the town. beldenhouse.com
